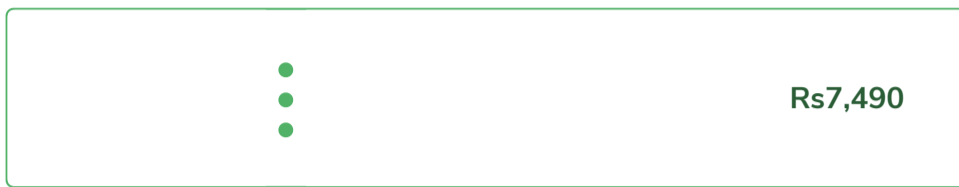
Shah Miftaur Rahman, co-founder of Wow! Momo, shared his experiences as an entrepreneur in the food industry.

Actress and model Apoorva Arora advised the youth to "be yourself since your flaws might not even be flaws. Learn to accept yourself and others as you and they are".

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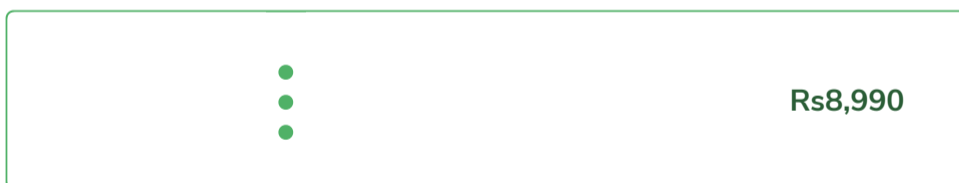
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
